

## **Circus Drive Person Specification**

- Circus Drive provides temporary homeless supported accommodation for single women and their children if there are no child care issues.  
Clients must be aged 16 upwards to be eligible to be referred to Circus Drive.
- Clients are referred by Glasgow City Council to project.
- Clients who are referred to project can be pregnant, or have their children in their care.
- Clients and their child/ren can only be accommodated until their child/ren are 30 months.
- Clients should be in receipt of benefits.
- Clients should be eligible to claim housing benefit.
- Clients with drug addictions should be stable and engaging with their Addictions Worker.
- Clients with alcohol addictions must be engaging with their Addictions Worker and working towards being abstinent from alcohol.
- Clients with mental health issues must be engaging with Mental Health Services.
- Clients must be at a point in their life where they wish to make changes to their current lifestyle.
- Clients must want to come to project and be willing to engage with staff and accept support that is being offered.
- Clients must stay at project 5 nights a week in line with Housing Benefit legislation.
- Clients can stay out of project 2 nights a week.
- Clients are not permitted any overnight visitors as accommodation is a single persons' accommodation unit.
